



## INDEMNITY FORM

1. Once your application is accepted, you must be aware that certain risks exist, which come with travel in Uganda, and you undertake all programs and related excursions entirely at your own risk. Travel to certain destinations such as Uganda may involve greater risks than others.

While Operation Uganda takes every precaution to ensure the safety of clients, no responsibility can be accepted for any death, injury or loss that might occur to you, sustained from any causes whatsoever.

2. It is your responsibility to review and assess any travel warnings or advisories issued by your country's governmental agency or your travel providers prior to booking any travel to Uganda. By providing the services to you, Operation Uganda does not declare that any particular travel destination is advisable, safe and without risk.

3. Operation Uganda does not accept any liability arising out of changes to itineraries, or any other matters relating to a program, due to factors outside its control. These include political disputes, wars, strikes, weather, etc. Any expenses incurred by you arising out of these changes are your responsibility. We reserve the right to cancel any program. In the event of an itinerary being canceled for whatever reason, you may choose a full refund of all moneys paid, or alternatively any other substitute itinerary Operation Uganda is in a position to offer. In the event you fail to join the program, or join after departure, or leave prior to completion, no refunds, or liability will be accepted by Operation Uganda.

4. Operation Uganda reserves the right to increase program prices due to any increases in transport, fuel and accommodation costs, entrance fees or fluctuation of exchange rates.

4. During the program should you, in the opinion of Operation Uganda or its authorized representative, be considered unsuitable for the program, due to being in breach of any laws or customs of Uganda, or by reason of causing inconvenience or difficulty to other members of the team, then Operation Uganda may ask you to leave. In such circumstances transportation back to the nearest Airport will be provided for your departure from Uganda. Operation Uganda will not be liable to make any refund to you, and no other liability by Operation Uganda to you will arise.

3. Alcohol is not permitted on the Jordan House grounds. Operation Uganda reserves the right to ask to you to leave the program if you are in breach of this condition.

4. You must be in possession of Travel Insurance, covering you for the entire period of your stay, a valid passport within a minimum of 6 months validity remaining after completion of travel, together with any necessary visas or required vaccinations, health or vaccination certificates, in particular a Yellow Fever certificate is required to travel to Uganda. Should you be refused entry to any country due to incorrect or incomplete documentation, Operation Uganda will not be held liable for any costs of such delays or repatriation costs for you.
