



OPERATION UGANDA PROJECT INFORMATION

Whether you are part of a youth group, a church, a community group or an individual, short-term visits are welcomed by Operation Uganda. As part of your visit to Uganda we currently have a variety of projects you can participate in ranging from ministry, medical, social work, teaching and building opportunities.

Individual short term visits

If you plan to come to Uganda as an individual we recommend you join our group departures throughout the year where you will travel alongside other individual travelers (group will be minimum of 4). Once your application form has been approved and all arrangements are confirmed; specific project information will be given 60 days prior to your departure date. The project will be chosen by Operation Uganda based on the overall skills of the group you are travelling with.

Projects we can offer include the following:

- Building
- Renovation
- Teaching
- Nursing/HIV Health clinics
- Social work in the community

We ask that all individuals aim to fundraise a minimum of \$500AUD towards the project they will be participating in while in Uganda. The money raised is to be deposited into the Operation Uganda Australian account a minimum of 30 days before departure. The money fundraised is tax deductible.

Please note if you are unable to fundraise the minimum amount of \$500AUD, you will still be able to participate in the short term visit, all we ask is that you aim to fundraise a minimum of \$500AUD, with the understanding that lesser donations under \$500AUD will be still be gladly accepted.

Team short term visits

If you are travelling as part of a team, church or organisation, we have a variety of projects you can get involved with for 2010 and 2011. They are as follows:

- Kitchen Renovation
- Bath/Toilet renovation
- Painting
- Education and School support
- Building projects in the community

*We also welcome any suggestions you may have on how your team/organisation can contribute to Operation Uganda through a particular project.



On your application please specify which particular project you are interested in or please list any suggestions for projects based on the skills and strengths of your team.

We ask that all teams/organisations aim to fundraise a minimum of \$10,000AUD as a team (this is not an individual requirement) towards the project they will be participating in while in Uganda. The money raised is to be deposited into the Operation Uganda Australian account a minimum of 30 days before departure. The money fundraised is tax deductible.

Please note if you are unable to fundraise the minimum amount of \$10,000AUD, your team will still be able to participate in the short term visit, all we ask that you aim to fundraise a minimum of \$10,000AUD, with the understanding that lesser donations under \$10,000AUD will be still be gladly accepted.

Plot of land for agricultural projects for Jordan House/community.

(In order to achieve these goals, the funds needed are between \$10,000 - \$100,000AUD or more).
